TIPS FOR SUCCESS

1. WATCH THE EPISODE!

3. GET YOUR MACHINE READY


Prepare for quilting success by ensuring that your machine needle is sharp. Are you experiencing breakage of your top thread, or skipped stitches? Do you hear a quiet popping sound when your needles move through the fabric? These are all signs that your needle is dull and it's time for a change.

Quilting Diagram




Can't you just feel the warm island winds? Why not use them as inspiration for your machine quilting designs? Elongated swirls can add movement to your quilt without overwhelming the intricate quilt pattern. You can adjust the spacing between the quilting lines depending on how dense you want the quilting to be.

Custom quilting does take a little longer than an all-over design, but the result is oh-so-worth the effort. When quilting the Grotto Quilt, I used serpentine lines to fill in the irregular shapes of the blocks. While they can be a little tricky to learn, they can really add impact to your quilt. If you get stuck, just try tracing the path with your finger. It will help your brain learn the path.
