TIPS FOR SUCCESS

1. WATCH THE EPISODE!

3. GET YOUR MACHINE READY


Prepare for quilting success by ensuring that your machine needle is sharp. Are you experiencing breakage of your top thread, or skipped stitches? Do you hear a quiet popping sound when your needles move through the fabric? These are all signs that your needle is dull and it's time for a change.

TURN IN EARLY


Quilting Diagram



After piecing a quilt as big as Santorini, it can be nice to use your walking foot to do some straight-line quilting. Especially since the angles of the piecing can be used as a guide for your quilting. That means no marking, just quilting!

UP ALL NIGHT

Spending just a little extra time on the quilting can make the negative space on the quilt pattern shine! Within the blocks, alternating between a continuous curve design and an angled "V" helps play up white and blues in the quilt pattern. In the long white strips, try a filler such as overlapping ribbon candy. Once you get the hang of it, you might find that it's quicker to quilt than you think!
