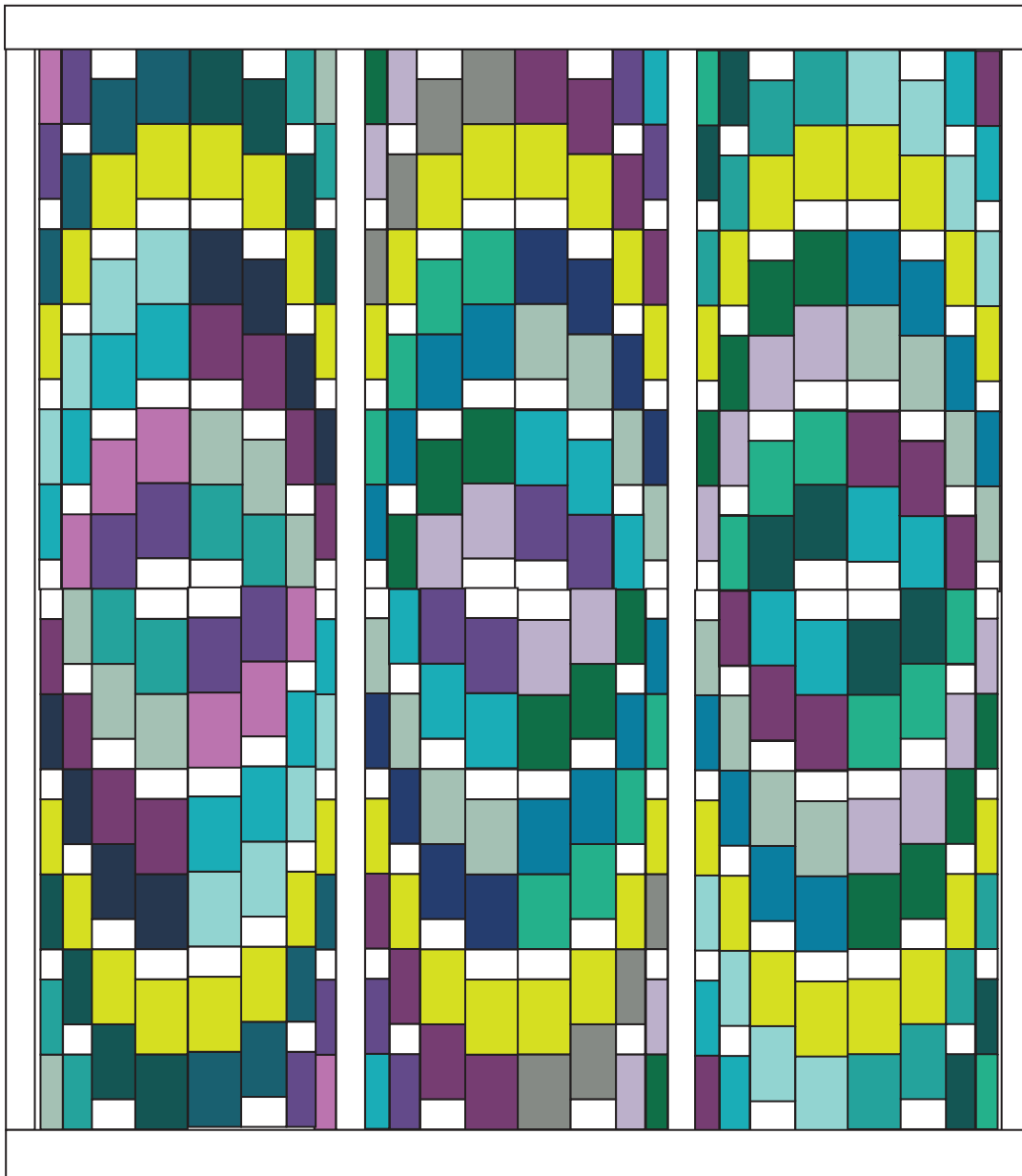

TIPS FOR SUCCESS

- 1. WATCH THE EPISODE!**
See how Angela pieces and quilts these designs as she works her way through the quilt top. Go to youtube.com/midnightquiltshow and search for Modern Bargello.
- 2. GET THE DIAGRAMS**
See the next few pages for Angela's sketched quilting designs. These are a great starting point for quilting ideas— whether you want to Turn In Early with something simpler, or stay Up All Night with more free-motion fun.
- 3. GET YOUR MACHINE READY**
Prepare for quilting success by ensuring that your machine needle is sharp. Are you experiencing breakage of your top thread, or skipped stitches? Do you hear a quiet popping sound when your needles move through the fabric? These are all signs that your needle is dull and it's time for a change.

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FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Fabric	Yardage	Cutting
Coordinating solids or prints (shown in <i>Boundless Collage Arabian Nights</i>)	One package of pre-cut 10" squares, or thirty 10" squares in coordinating fabrics	Blocks A and B: Divide into 6 groups of 5 squares. Subcut each piece into two 5" x 10" rectangles.
Coordinating Solid (shown in <i>Boundless Collage Ripple Wild Lime</i>)	1 yard	Blocks A and B: Cut 3 strips 5" x WOF. Subcut into 12 rectangles 5" x 10". Binding: Cut 8 strips, 2.5" x WOF.
Background Fabric (shown in <i>Boundless Collage Ripple Marshmallow</i>)	1 $\frac{5}{8}$ yards	Block A and B: Cut 9 strips 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Subcut into 36 rectangles, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10". Sashing: Cut 7 strips, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Top and Bottom Borders: Cut 4 strips, 4" x WOF.
Backing Fabric (shown in <i>Boundless Solids Aquarius</i>)	4 yards	Cut two 2-yard lengths, seam along longest edge. Seam will run horizontally across quilt back.

*WOF= Width of Fabric

MODERN BARGELLO QUILT PATTERN

Block A

1. Using the first group of fabric, gather:

- One of each of the 5" x 10" rectangles from the first group of squares
- Three 2 ½" x 10" rectangles white solid
- One 5" x 10" rectangle green solid

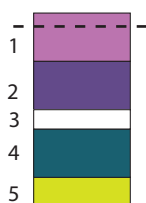
2. Arrange the strips as shown in the diagram below, noting the placement of the solid green and solid white rectangles.



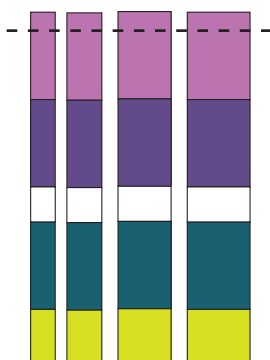
3. Sew the rectangles together along the long (10") sides to make a unit measuring 10" x 33 ½". Press.



4. Fold each unit in half right sides together, matching short (10") edges. Sew, joining the top and bottom edge to make a tube. Reposition if needed so that the wrong side of Fabric 1 is face up at the top of the unit.

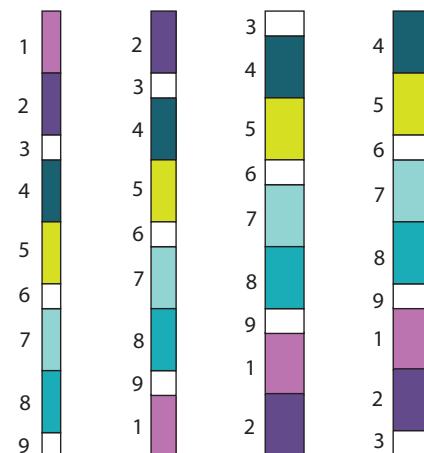


5. Subcut the tube into 4 units: 1 ½"-wide, 2"-wide, 3"-wide and 3 ½"-wide.



6. Next, you'll release (rip) the seams between specific fabrics on each tube, to give you the necessary color order.

- Working with the 1 ½"-wide unit, remove the stitches in the seam between Fabric 1 and Fabric 9
- Working with the 2"-wide unit, remove the stitches in the seam between Fabric 1 and Fabric 2.
- Working with the 3"-wide unit, remove the stitches in the seam between Fabric 2 and Fabric 3.
- Working with the 3 ½"-wide unit, remove the stitches between Fabric 3 and Fabric 4.



7. With wrong sides together, sew the long edges of the first two units (1 ½"-wide and 2"-wide) together. Repeat, sewing the remaining two units (3"-wide and 3 ½"-wide) together. Press. Sew these two units together to create the unit shown, measuring 8 ½" x 33 ½".



8. Repeat the steps above with remaining fabric from first group to make a second matching Block A.

9. Using 2 more groups of fabric, repeat the steps above to make 4 more Block A. You'll have six blocks total.

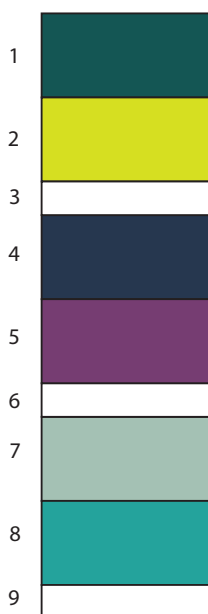
MODERN BARGELLO QUILT PATTERN

Block B

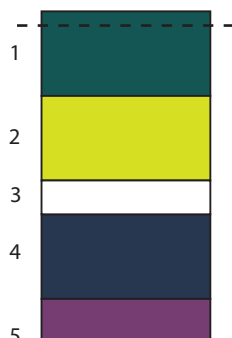
1. Using the next group of fabric, gather:

- One of each of the 5" x 10" rectangles cut from the squares
- Three 2 1/2" x 10" rectangles white solid
- One 5" x 10" rectangle green solid

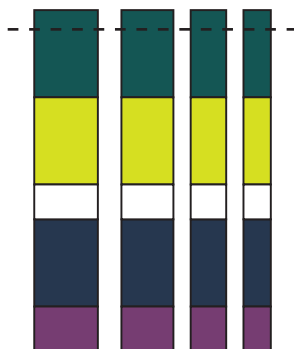
2. Arrange the strips as shown, noting the placement of the solid green and solid white rectangles. Sew the rectangles together along the long (10") sides to make a unit measuring 10" x 33 1/2". Press.



3. Sew fabric 1 and fabric 9 right sides together along the short (10") edge to make a tube. Reposition if needed so that the wrong side of Fabric 1 is facing you, at the top of the tube.

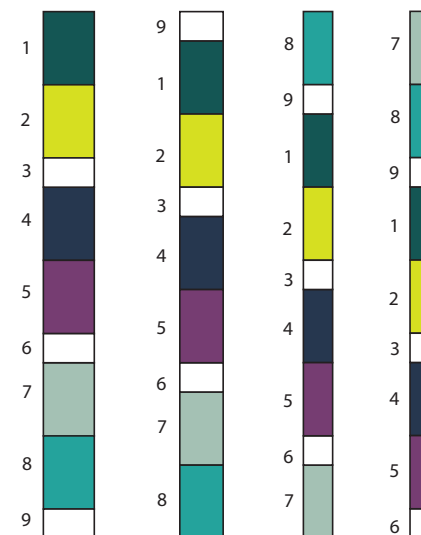


4. Subcut tube into 4 units: 3 1/2"-wide, 3"-wide, 2"-wide and 1 1/2"-wide.



5. Next, you'll release (rip) the seams between specific fabrics on each tube, to give you the necessary color order.

- Working with the 3 1/2"-wide unit, remove the stitches in the seam between Fabric 1 and Fabric 9.
- Working with the 3"-wide unit, remove the stitches in the seam between Fabric 8 and Fabric 9.
- Working with the 2"-wide unit, remove the stitches in the seam between Fabric 7 and Fabric 8.
- Working with the 1 1/2"-wide unit, remove the stitches between Fabric 6 and Fabric 7.



6. With wrong sides together, sew the long edges of the first two units (3"-wide and 3 1/2"-wide) together. Repeat, sewing the remaining two units (1 1/2"-wide and 2"-wide) together. Press. Sew these two units together to create the unit shown, measuring 8 1/2" x 33 1/2".



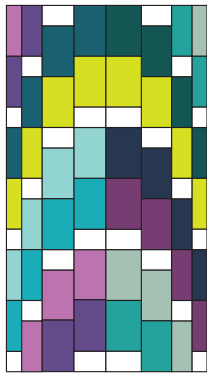
7. Repeat to make a second matching Block B.

8. Using the remaining two groups of fabric, repeat to make 4 more Block B. You'll have six blocks total.

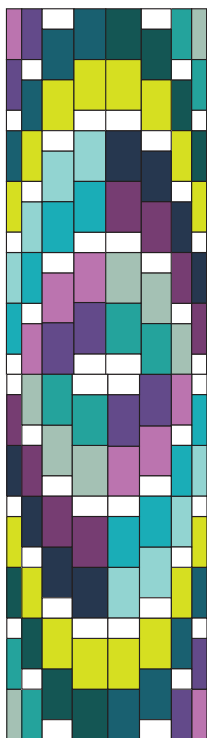
MODERN BARGELLO QUILT PATTERN

Assembly

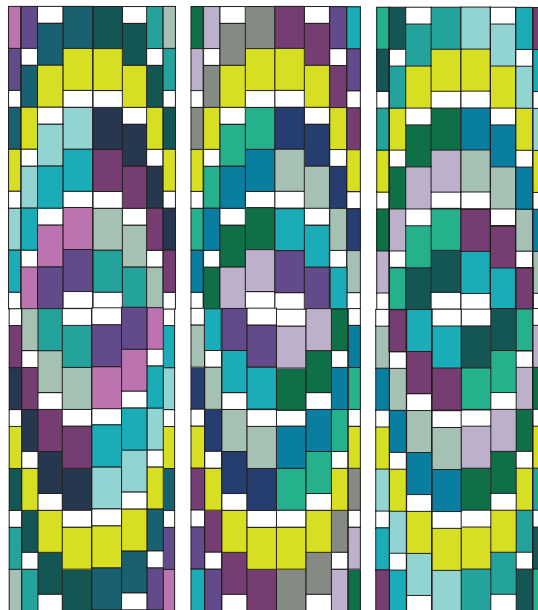
1. Gather two matching Block A and two matching Block B. Sew an A and B block together as shown in the diagram. Press.



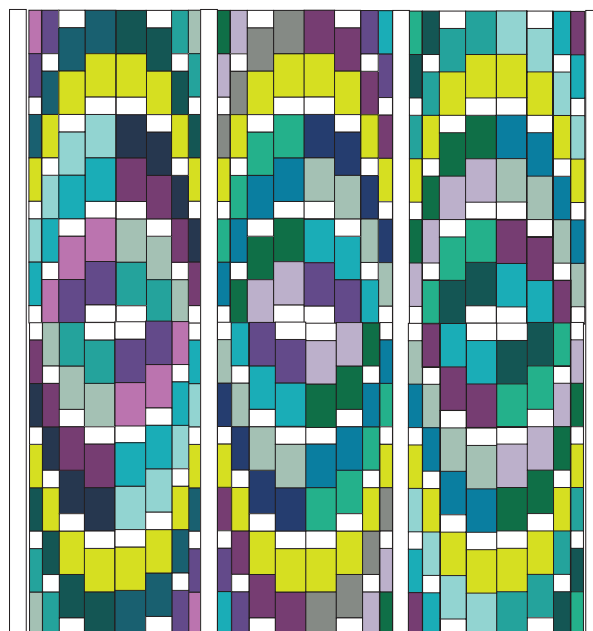
2. Repeat with another A and B block to make a total of two units measuring $16\frac{1}{2}'' \times 33\frac{1}{2}''$.
3. Rotate one unit and sew to the bottom of the other unit as shown. Press. Unit will measure $16\frac{1}{2}'' \times 66\frac{1}{2}''$.



4. Repeat steps 1-3 twice to make a total of 3 units.



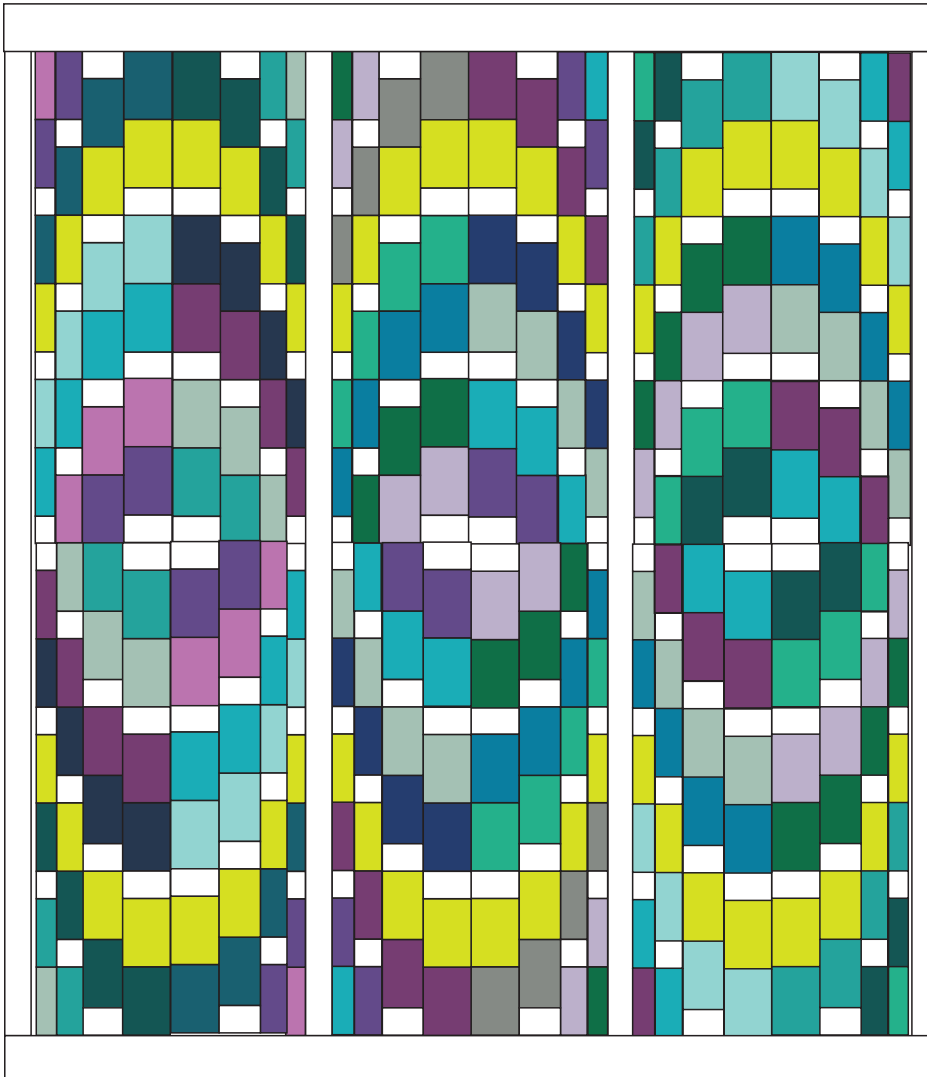
5. Sew all of the $2\frac{1}{2}''$ long strips of white solid together to make one long strip, press seams. From this strip, cut four $66\frac{1}{2}''$ long sashing strips. Sew a sashing strip to the left long side of each bargello unit. Sew each unit together, then add remaining sashing strip at right edge of quilt as shown in diagram. Press.

Assembly

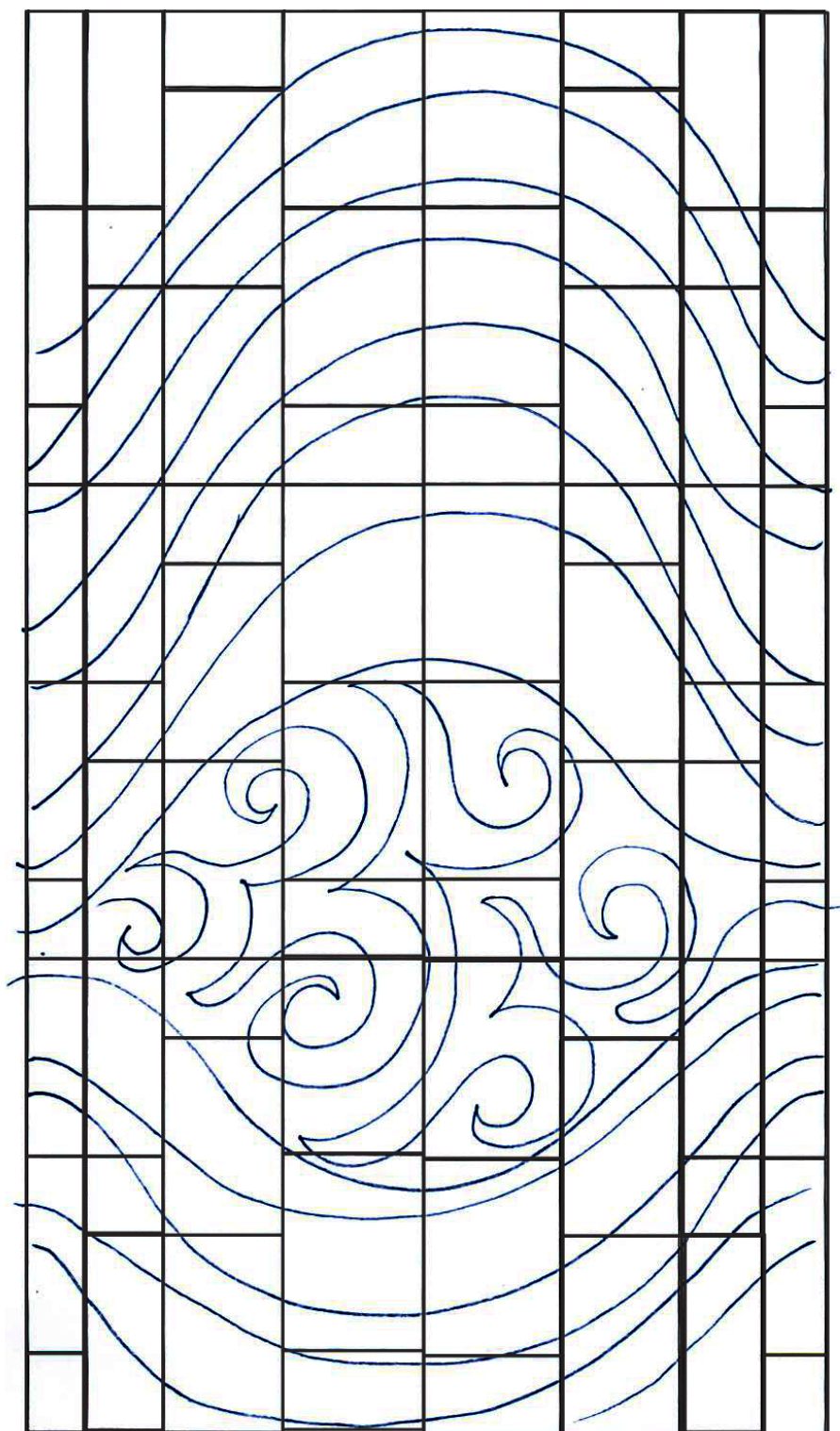
6. Sew two pairs of 4"-wide strips together along short edge, press. Cut each strip to 56 1/2" long. With right sides together, sew top border to quilt. Repeat with bottom border as shown. Top should measure 56 1/2"x 73 1/2".



7. Quilt, bind and enjoy!

TURN IN EARLY

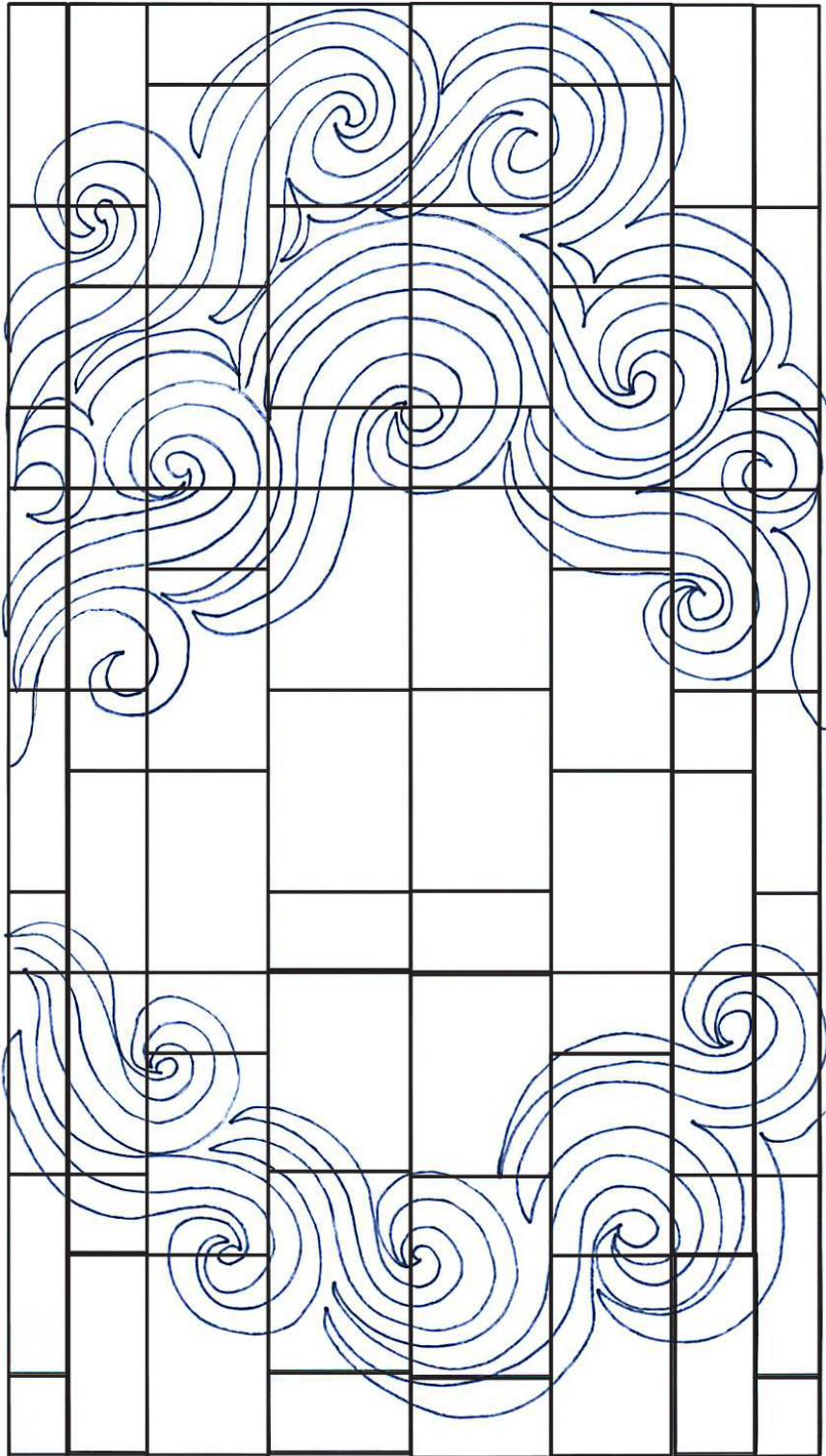
Quilting Diagram
