TIPS FOR SUCCESS

1 WATCH THE EPISODE!

3. GET YOUR MACHINE READY


Prepare for quilting success by ensuring that your machine needle is sharp. Are you experiencing breakage of your top thread, or skipped stitches? Do you hear a quiet popping sound when your needles move through the fabric? These are all signs that your needle is dull and it's time for a change.





Quilting Diagram




The beautiful, bold batiks shine all on their own! Quilting some gentle wavy lines will mimic the illusion of movement from the piecing, without being too complicated. You can use your free-motion quilting foot or your walking foot; whichever you prefer!




UP ALL NIGHT

Quilting Diagram



The plume feather is an excellent design for filling in the pointy diamond shapes where the blocks come together. Extending the individual "ferns" of the feather to the edge of the area will help the designs fill the space completely. Save a little time (and quilting stress) by using variations of continuous curve in the other areas of the blocks.
