## Tips For Success

1. PATTERN: This kit includes a printed version of your pattern - be sure to read through your entire pattern before you begin cutting your fabrics! In some cases, a digital version of your pattern may be available for download in your pattern library. Simply log in to your Bluprint account to access it. If for any reason a newer version of your pattern becomes available, we'll send you an email with instructions about how to access it.
2. BLADE: Is your rotary blade sharp and ready? A sharp blade will require you to use less energy when cutting! If you see small threads still intact when you cut through your fabric, that's a good indication it's time to change your blade.
3. MACHINE: Prepare for sewing success by ensuring that your sewing machine needle is sharp. Are you experiencing breakage of your top thread, or skipped stitches? Do you hear a quiet popping sound when your needles move through the fabric? These are all signs that your needle is dull and it's time for a change.

Please read the entire pattern once through before starting. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance unless otherwise directed.

## Cutting Instructions



From Pink \#1 and Pink \#2 Fabrics, cut:
(3) $4^{1 / 2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips, into:
(16) $4 \frac{1}{1 / 2^{\prime \prime}}$ squares for Block $A$
(16) $4^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ pieces for Block A
(1) $9^{3} / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip, into:
(4) $9^{3} / 4^{\prime \prime}$ squares for Block A Half-Square Triangles
(3) $71^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips, into:
(15) $7^{1 / 1 / 4 "}$ squares for Block B Flying Geese


From Turquoise Fabric, cut:
(2) $2^{1 / 2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips, into:
(8) $2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ pieces for Block A
(1) $4^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip, into:
(16) $2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ pieces for Block $A$


From Blue \#1 Fabric, cut:
(3) $4^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips, into:
(16) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares for Block $A$
(16) $4^{1 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}}$ pieces for Block $A$
(1) $9^{3} / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip, into:
(4) $93 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ squares for Block $A$


From Blue \#2, cut:
(3) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips, into:
(12) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares for Block $A$
(12) $4^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ pieces for Block $A$
(1) $9^{3} / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip, into:
(3) $93 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ squares for Block $A$


From Lavender Fabric, cut:
(2) $2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips, into:
(7) $2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ pieces for Block $A$
(1) $4^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip, into:
(14) $2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ pieces for Block $A$


## Pattern Instructions

NOTE: At the beginning of this pattern you will find instructions for making Half Square Triangles and Flying Geese. These techniques are used throughout the rest of the pattern. You can refer back to these technique instructions as you make your blocks.

## Half-Square Triangles

STEP 1
On the back of a $9^{3} / 4^{\prime \prime}$ square of Background, draw two diagonal lines to form an "X". Place a drawn background square, right sides together on a $9^{3} / 4^{\prime \prime}$ square of Pink \#1. Sew a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ from each side of both lines. Cut in quarters, horizontally and vertically, as shown. Note that the half-way measurement is $4^{7} / 8^{\prime \prime}$. Cut on the drawn lines. Open and press towards the background. Square to $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. You should have 8 HalfSquare Triangles.

## Flying Geese

STEP 1
Gather a $7^{1 / 4^{\prime \prime}}$ square of Pink \#1 Fabric and (4) $3^{7} / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares of Background Fabric. On the wrong side of the $3^{77 / 8^{\prime \prime}}$ squares of Background Fabric, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner. Place 2 drawn squares, right sides together on the corners of a $71 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ square of Pink \#1 Fabric, as shown. Sew ${ }^{1 / 4 \prime}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ on both sides of the line. Cut on the line and press out.


## STEP 2

Place a drawn square on a corner of the piece as shown. Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ from both sides of the line. Cut on the line and press out. The Flying Geese should measure $3^{1 / 2 \prime} \times 2^{1 / 2 \prime}$. You will make a total of 4 per Background and Pink.


## Block A

STEP 1
Following General Piecing Instructions, make (8) HalfSquare Triangles using Pink \#1 and Background Fabric.

## Pattern Instructions

STEP 2
Sew (2) Half-Square Triangles from Step 1, a $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square of Pink \#1, and a $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square of Background together as shown. Press in the direction of the arrows. The unit should measure $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Repeat to make (4).

## STEP 3

Sew a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece of Turquoise and a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece of Pink \#1 together end to end. Press away from the Turquoise. Repeat to make 2. Sew a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece of Pink \#1 to both ends of a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece of Turquoise. Press away from the Turquoise.


Make 2

STEP 4
Sew the units from Steps 2 and 3 together to make a block. Press in the direction of the arrows. The block should measure $181 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square.


STEP 5
Repeat to make a total of (4) each of Block A using Pink \#1 and Pink \#2 with Turquoise. Make (4) of Block A using Blue \#1 with Lavender and (3) of Block A using Blue \#2 with Lavender.

## Pattern Instructions

## Block B

STEP 1
On the backs of (4) $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares of Aqua, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner. Place a drawn square, right sides together, on opposite corners of a $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square of Pink \#3. Sew on the lines and press out. Trim the bottom two layers to $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$. Place and sew two more $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares on remaining corners. Trim the bottom two layers to $1 / 4$ " and press out.


STEP 2
Make (8) half square triangles using the General Piecing Instructions with a $53 / 4$ " square of Pink \#3 and a 53/4" square of background. Press towards the Background Fabric. The Half-Square Triangles should measure $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. You will only need (4) for each Block B, save the remaining for another Block B.


## STEP 3

Sew a $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ piece of Background and a $1 \frac{1}{2^{\prime \prime}} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece of Background to a Half-Square Triangle from Step 2. Press in the direction of the arrows. Repeat to make (4).


Make 4

## STEP 4

Sew a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip of Aqua and a $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip of Background together along the length to make a Strip Set. Press towards the Background. Repeat to make (10) strip sets. Cut each Strip Set into (6) 6½" segments for a total of 60. (Use 4 per Block B)

Cut each Strip Set into (6) 61/2" segments for a total of 60

## STEP 5

Sew the unit from Step 1, (4) units from Step 3 and (4) segments from Step 4 together, as shown. Press in the direction of the arrows. The block should be $121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square.


## STEP 6

Following General Piecing Instructions, make (4) Flying Geese using Pink \#1 and Background Fabric. Press towards the Background Fabric. Repeat to make a total of (4) Flying Geese, using Pink \#2.

## STEP 7

Sew (4) Fying Geese together as shown, randomly placing Pink \#1 and Pink \#2. Press in the direction of the arrows. Repeat to make (2) units.

## STEP 8

Sew the unit from Step 5, (2) Flying Geese units from Step 7 and (1) $6 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ square of Blue \#3 together, as shown. Press in the direction of the arrows. Block $B$ should measure $181 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Repeat to make a total of (15) Block B's.

## Pattern Instructions

## Quilt Top Assembly

STEP 1
Lay out the blocks, alternating Block A's and Block B's, as shown. Note placement of Block A Pinks and Block A Blues and rotate Block B's, as shown. Sew together blocks in each row. Press rows in opposite directions. Sew rows together and press down.

## Finishing The Quilt

STEP 1
Layer, baste, and bind with $214^{\prime \prime}$ Background Binding Strips.
